
## James Gillespie's High School Parent Council Treasurer's Report – year ended 31st July 2018



JGHS Parent Council raises funds for the school for two purposes:

- 1. To support the school community through social activities, e.g. by providing tea/coffee at parent teacher evenings;
- 2. To raise funds for the school, e.g. through Easy Fundraiser; Christmas Appeal. The chart above shows a breakdown of this year's fundraising.
- Refreshments at Parent Events (£728.42) which is more than last year (£457.73)
- **Donations** at the Christmas Concert **(£1432.87)** which is around the same as raised last year (£1457.97).
- Online EasyFundraising (<a href="mailto:easyfundraising.org.uk">easyfundraising.org.uk</a>) we raised £551.27 which is around two thirds of what was raised last year (£771.95).
- **Hospitality,** we spent £113.75 on the Teacher Appreciation Day.

**Small Sums Fund** – We support the teachers by funding resources for a range of projects. This year we gave £4432.46 an increase over (£3023.32) in previous year.

**Finally, at 31**<sup>st</sup> **July 2018**, we had slightly less than at the end of last year, (£6923.82), with a total of £6196.57.

## **Small Sums Funding - distributed September 2017**

Funding is distributed to the school staff via the Small Sums Fund. Each year, staff submit bids for funding and a group of parents decide which will be funded. The intention is to provide additional resources to support and enhance the educational experience particularly in areas not supported by City of Edinburgh Council.
