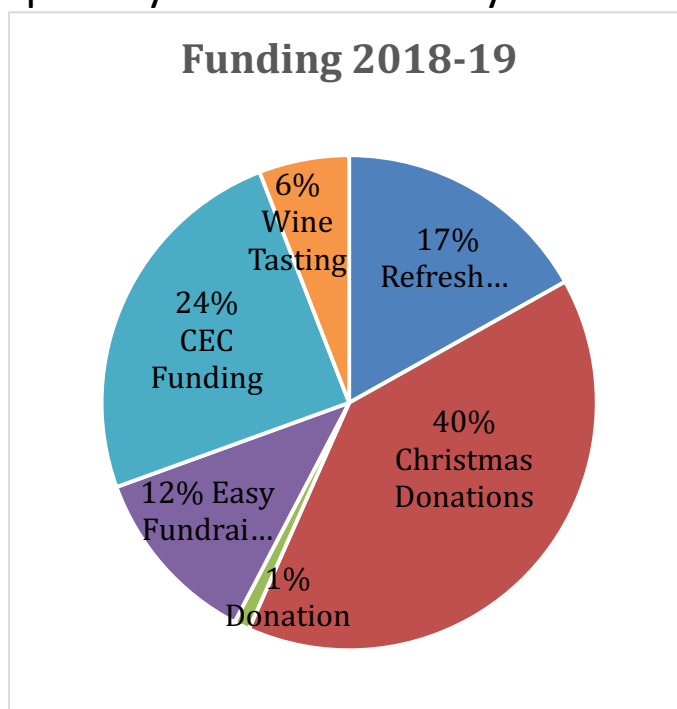


James Gillespie's High School Parent Council Treasurer's Report – year ended 31st July 2019



JGHS Parent Council raises funds for the school for two purposes:

1. To support the school community through social activities, e.g. by providing tea/coffee at parent teacher evenings;
2. To raise funds for the school, e.g. through Easy Fundraiser; Christmas Appeal.

The chart above shows funding and fundraising received this year.



Refreshments at Parent Events (**£823.02**) which is slightly more than last year (£728.42).



Donations at the Christmas Concert (**£1939.92**) which is more than raised last year (£1432.87).



Donations, we received **£50**.



Online EasyFundraising (easyfundraising.org.uk) - we raised **£575.97** which is more than was raised last year (£551.27).



Wine tasting, we raised **£287.63**.



Funding from City of Edinburgh Council - we received **£1201.71** (based on number attending JGHS) compared to last year's £1106.40.

Finally, at 31st July 2019, we had **£5341.32** which is slightly less when compared to £6196.57 at the end of last year.

Small Sums Fund – We support the teachers by funding resources for a range of projects. This year we gave **£5733.50** an increase over (£4432.46) in previous year.
