

Consortia: Why go digital?

No travel time required for learners (impact on other subjects)

Flexibility in timetabling: Not restricted to a 'travel' column on Tues/Thurs – opportunities for live and pre-recorded content (synchronous and asynchronous)

No travel costs (£5865 last session including £3198 for taxis)

No physical barriers: opportunities to access the widest possible offer from CEC schools (not simply Adv H, H, N5, but other SCQF courses)

lessons are being organised and delivered through eSgoil



learning video sessions which are being made available via West OS.



SUPPORTED content material created by practitioners searchable via an online blog.

How will it look?



Pupils access courses online (created by CEC teachers and stored on Teams, or from the national resource of LIVE content (e-sgoil) or RECORDED content (WestOS))

A designated teacher from a CEC school would meet pupils on Teams once per week (after school) for '1 period' for a live tutorial/lesson

Schools – Key Messages

- 2500 video lessons (and growing every day)
- Free of Charge
- Contributing factor to raising attainment
- Recovery and catch-up
- Promoting collaboration and consistent approaches to L&T across LAs and RICs
- Embedding digital practices into pedagogy and increasing practitioner confidence
- Provides a consistent model of delivery
- Equitable access to resources and support

Parents/Pupils – Key Messages

- Free of Charge
- 24/7 availability of support (whenever, wherever)
- Reassurance around quality of resources (3 step QA process)
- Ease of use/accessibility (appears as a library within ClickView)

Where are we now?

Responses from schools about face-to-face and digital consortia 2020-21 (AH Geog and N5/H Computing digital)

Survey to schools/teachers to gather interest in digital delivery (teacher name, subject, level) – returns in December showed 27 teachers are interested in delivering via digital consortia
