



PVG checks by 1 July

- 1. The organisation works with children <18
- The PC could exercise power or influence by making decisions of an operational or strategic nature that could have an impact on a number of children
- 3. The PC holds a position of responsibility in an organisation which has as one of its main purposes the provision of benefits for or to children
- 4. The contact with children (as described in 2 above) is part of the normal duties of the role.


